The Department of Aviation recommends utilizing HOUSTON-GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL PURCHASING COOPERATIVE PROGRAM CONTRACT NUMBER SM10-08 JO5 HGAC EXP 9-30-2010 CRACK SEAL MELTER. The Crack Seal Melter is used in the preventative maintenance of runways, taxiways, parking lots and other pavement areas at El Paso International Airport. The dual heated hose option will allow a wider path of work and the compressor will allow for cleaning the crack prior to applying the melted coal tar. The following are the factors used to evaluate the use of this procurement program as the best approach:

1. Is there an urgent need for the product/service? In other words, is time of the essence?

Yes. Time is of an essence. The crack seal machine is need for application of coal tar prior to the El Paso rain season. Without sealing the cracks water infiltrates into the sub-base of the runways or taxiways causing erosion of same which in turn causes more cracks.

2. Does the purchase through the Program promote the standardization of equipment?

No. This is a one time purchase. We expect this machine to last approximately 7 years. The machine is warranted for the first year. After that El Paso International Airport automotive mechanics' will maintain the machine.

3. Does the purchase through the Program support local business? If not, is there a comparable product/service available locally?

> The Department of Aviation maintains airfield pavement areas as well as parking lots and non-dedicated roads. Properly maintaining these surfaces extends the life of the pavement. The airport has one machine which was purchased in 2000 and has cost \$14,029.43 to maintain during it's life. Although the cost to maintain has not been excessive, the sealer must be applied when the weather is cooler. This year we had a major component fail which caused about 60 days of down time. With only one machine we were not able to cover all of the areas in our maintenance plan. The addition of another machine will enable two crews to work simultaneously and therefore insure that all surfaces are sealed each year.

> The cost of a new machine is \$65,796.00 through the Houston-Galveston Area Council Purchasing Cooperative Program Contract # SM10-08-J05 HGAC expires 9-30-2010.
