ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 11598, 11902, 15748, 16971, AND 17008, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ABOLISHING THE EL PASO INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the El Paso International Bridge Commission (the "Commission") was first created in 1993 to be an advisory body to the Mayor and Council on matters regarding the international bridges owned and operated by the City; and

WHEREAS, the initial ordinance was amended numerous times; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is no longer needed as a standing board of the City holding regular meetings, as its duties can be transferred to the Committee on Border Relations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso agrees to abolish the Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the International Bridge Commission, established October 19, 1993 by Ordinance No. 11598, and amended by Ordinances No. 11902 on May 10, 1994, No. 15748 on April 6, 2004, No. 16971 on August 19, 2008, and No. 17008 on September 30, 2008 be abolished, and that Ordinances Nos. 11598, 11902, 15748, 16971 and 17008 be repealed.
