1. Discussion and action on calling a special election to fill a City Council vacancy in the Office of Representative for District No. 3.

Representative Lizarraga explained that Council needs to retire into executive session to obtain a legal briefing.

Mayor Pro Tempore Perez stated that Council would return to have a discussion in open session.

Motion made by Mayor Pro Tempore Ordaz Perez, seconded by Representative Salcido, and unanimously carried that the City Council retire into **EXECUTIVE SESSION** at 9:13 a.m. pursuant to Section 3.5A of the El Paso City Charter and the Texas Government Code, Sections 551.071 - 551.089 to discuss the item:

Representative Salcido asked Representative Hernandez if she had any comments.

Representative Hernandez explained that she stands by the information submitted by her attorney and stated that she intends to continue serving her district until the end of her term.

Representative Svarzbein asked what the deadline would be for calling the special election.

Ms. Karla Nieman, City Attorney, explained that per State law the deadline would be September 20, 2019.

Representative Svarzbein expressed his desire to postpone the item.

Representative Rivera asked if the special election would be at no cost to the public.

Ms. Nieman agreed and explained that the action proposed by Representative Svarzbein would be to postpone the item until the next City Council meeting.

Representative Morgan explained that he wanted to be clear that they would not be voting on whether or not to accept Representative Hernandez's resignation.

Mr. Lowell F. Denton, outside counsel, explained the context regarding the timelines and provisions regarding election law surrounding automatic resignations.

Mayor Pro Tempore Ordaz Perez explained that the law is clear regarding an automatic resignation and said the discussion at hand is only on calling for a special election. She commented that she supports postponing the item until the next meeting.

Representative Hernandez stated she wished that Council would move forward with the item today and asked for better communication.
