A resolution that the temporary sale and service of alcoholic beverages by Drag-In, LLC and Mercado Negro, LLC d/b/a Black Market, in the closed portions of City rights-of-way on East Franklin Avenue between North Santa Fe Street and North Oregon Street, and North El Paso Street between East Franklin Avenue and West Main Drive from 5:00 p.m. Saturday, September 27, 2014 through 2:00 a.m. Sunday, September 28, 2014 is a permissible activity in conjunction with Trapfest; and that Drag-In, LLC and Mercado Negro, LLC d/b/a Black Market be authorized to use Cleveland Square Park from 1:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. Sunday, September 28, 2014 for the event, and from 2:00 am to 6:00 am for purposes of cleaning and restoring park to its original condition in accordance with City Code Section 13.24.040(E) (CSEV14-00156) District 8.

Reservation of Cleveland Square Park with Park Permit #22947, allows the Parks and Recreation Director to administratively approve the possession and consumption of alcohol within parkland in accordance subject to the conditions of Section 13.24.130(C) of the El Paso Municipal Code. The applicant is additionally requesting the extension of park hours from 1:00 am to 6:00 am on Sunday, September 28, 2014; per Section 13.24.040(A), Council must approve this request for an extension of park hours.

As per Section 15.08.120(D) of the El Paso Municipal Code, the event application was submitted to the Downtown Management District (DMD) and the Ad Hoc Committee (AHC) met for consideration of and

approved the Event on Tuesday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Council must approve the sale and service of alcohol in the identified portions of the right-of-way in order for the Applicant to proceed with the event as described by the attached application. The Applicant assumes full responsibility for the TABC Permittee and is responsible for providing event insurance in accordance with Section 15.08.120(G) of the El Paso Municipal Code.

## **RESOLUTION**

### **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:**

**WHEREAS**, Drag-In, LLC (hereinafter referred to as “Grantee”) is producing Trapfest to be open to the public from 5:00 p.m. Saturday, September 27, 2014 through 2:00 a.m. Sunday, September 28, 2014 (hereinafter referred to as “Event”) and the Grantee has obtained a valid permit issued through the City’s Parks and Recreation Department under City Code Section 13.24.130(C) for the use of Cleveland Square Park during normal and extended park hours in conjunction with the Event; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grantee has submitted an application for a Special Privilege Permit pursuant to Title 15.08.120(D) of the El Paso Municipal Code, for the use and closure of portions of City rights-of-way on East Franklin Avenue between North Santa Fe Street and North Oregon Street, and North El Paso Street between East Franklin Avenue and West Main Drive in conjunction with the Event; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grantee has indicated their intent to authorize Mercado Negro, LLC d/b/a Black Market (hereinafter referred to as “TABC Permittee”) to provide for the temporary sale and service of alcoholic beverages within the identified closed portions of City rights-of-way during the Event; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC) requires that the City Council for the City of El Paso approve, as a permissible activity, the sale and service of alcoholic beverages within City rights-of-way during the Event, prior to issuance of such permit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grantee desires to request an extension of park hours under City Code Section 13.24.040(E) for the use of Cleveland Square Park between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Sunday, September 28, 2014 in conjunction with the Event; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grantee assumes full responsibility for the planning, coordination, management and production of the Event, and for the TABC Permittee, including verification that the TABC Permittee has obtained a permit for the temporary sale and service of alcoholic beverages from the TABC prior to the Event.

### **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:**

That the temporary sale and service of alcoholic beverages by Drag-In, LLC and Mercado Negro, LLC d/b/a Black Market, in the closed portions of City rights-of-way on East Franklin Avenue between North Santa Fe Street and North Oregon Street, and North El Paso Street between East Franklin Avenue and West Main Drive from 5:00 p.m. Saturday, September 27, 2014 through 2:00 a.m. Sunday, September 28, 2014 is a permissible activity in conjunction with Trapfest; and

That Drag-In, LLC and Mercado Negro, LLC d/b/a Black Market be authorized to use Cleveland Square Park from 1:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. Sunday, September 28, 2014 for the event, and from 2:00 am to 6:00 am for purposes of cleaning and restoring park to its original condition in accordance with City Code Section 13.24.040(E).

A permittee shall comply with all permit requirements, conditions, and with all applicable laws and ordinances and the responsible party must carry the permit during the conduct of the event or use and must show the permit to any person upon request.

The permittee is responsible for the conduct and behavior of their guests and participants.

The permit is not transferrable.

If the permittee fails to fulfill any of the conditions stated in the permit, the director may terminate the permit immediately and such termination may result in ineligibility for future permits, removal, fine, arrest, and/or forfeiture of fees.

The permittee shall be responsible for cleaning and removing all litter and debris left on the city park, facility or identifiable area immediately upon the conclusion of the event. If the permittee fails to clean and remove all such litter and debris upon conclusion of the event, the city may perform such cleaning and the permittee will be responsible for the costs of the city cleaning. Payment of any city cleaning costs will be due and payable within ten days of receipt of the bill from the city comptroller.

\*\*\*\*\*AMPLIFICATION NOTICE \*\*\*\*\*

The permittee shall comply with all permit requirements and conditions and with all applicable law and ordinances, including but not limited to the City's noise ordinance, Chapter 9.40 of this code.

No amplification permits will be granted between the hours of 10:00pm - 7:00am that are within residential real property or at an institution, business or facility with sleeping facilities.

Prohibited areas include San Jacinto Plaza (other than on stage), within the City Hall parking lot, the Civic Center Plaza other than the patio area on the westerly side of City Hall, on the sidewalks abutting the Zoo. Additionally, residences, hospitals and performing arts and motion picture facilities cannot be targeted.

No amplification shall take place in the downtown government/business area for more than thirty minutes every two hours of time between the hours of 8:00 am - 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, except legal holidays.

Amplification will not be used for the purpose of advertising goods, property, services, or entertainment, where the primary purpose of which advertising is the making of a profit for a business.

\*\*\*\*\*CONDITIONS OF USE \*\*\*\*\*

1. The permittee shall comply with all instructions and rules and with all applicable laws and ordinances.

2. The permittee shall, immediately upon the conclusion of the event, clean and remove all litter and debris left on the park and sidewalks used by participants and spectators.

3. City parks are closed to the public every night between 10:00pm - 6:00 am (Municipal Code 13.24.040)

4. No person shall camp in any city park or playground (Municipal Code 13.24.070)

5. No vehicles are allowed into or onto park areas (Municipal Code 13.24.090)

6. No person shall throw or deposit litter in any park except in public receptacles. Where public receptacles are not provided, all waste shall be carried away from the park by the person responsible for its presence and properly disposed of. (Municipal Code 9.04.340)

7. Every person having custody of any dog(s) must have means of control by a secure leash or by some other equivalent means of direct physical control. (Municipal Code 7.12.010)

8. It is unlawful for any person owning an animal to permit the animal to defecate upon the city's public property unless the person immediately removes the feces and properly disposes of it. In addition, it is unlawful for any person to walk an animal on the city's public property without carrying at all times a suitable container or other instrument for the removal and disposal of animal feces. (Municipal Code 7.08.010)

9. Destruction or damage of trees is prohibited. (Municipal Code 9.11.010)

10. Charitable solicitations must be in compliance with Municipal Code 5.24

11. No person shall possess or consume an alcoholic beverage in any city park (except as provided in Municipal Code 13.24.130)

12. Glass containers are prohibited (Municipal Code 13.24.190)

13. City not liable for inclement weather. No Refunds.
