POLICY FOR NAMING MASS TRANSIT DEPARTMENT TRANSFER CENTERS

- 1. The general presumption will be that the name of all Transfer Centers reflect its geographical location within the City of El Paso.
- 2. In addition to the "geographical" name of a Transfer Center, Transfer Centers can be named after persons provided the following criteria and steps are followed:
 - a. The name shall not duplicate the name of any other Transfer Center in El Paso.
 - b. The name shall not endorse or advocate any religion or specific religious belief, nor shall the name have an obscene connotation or malevolently portray, demean, or intimidate any racial or ethnic group.
 - c. The extent of public support for or opposition against a name shall be taken into account when deciding on a name.
 - d. In the event that the name of a deceased person is proposed, that person shall have been deceased for at least one year before consideration, have been prominent in El Paso or elsewhere and shall have demonstrated a continued commitment and made an extraordinary contribution, preferably to public transit locally, nationally or internationally. Persons not associated with public transit may be considered but shall meet all other criteria. Any living person proposed shall have a made a worthy and extraordinary contribution, preferably to public transit, or be extremely prominent locally, in Texas, nationally or internationally.
 - e. The name of a Transfer Center shall not be changed without extraordinary good reasons.
- 3. Requests for naming of a Transfer Center shall be submitted to the Director of the Mass Transit Department, by application, with 50 original signatures, and a full biography must be submitted of the person whose name is being recommended.
- 4. The Director will present the request to the Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) for discussion and recommendation, and if applicable, to the Mass Transit Department Board.
- 5. Person(s) or Organization requesting the Transfer Center name shall appear before the CAC.
- 6. Once the CAC has made a recommendation regarding the naming of a Transfer Center, the Director of the Mass Transit Department will present the recommendation to the Mass Transit Department Board for approval.
