

Scope of Work

<u>Project will provide improvements to the existing Mission Valley Transfer center which</u> includes:

- Two (2) additional bus bays
- On-street signs
- Electrical
- Pedestrian path/crossings and landscaping
- Installation of three (3) canopies
- Construction of pavement replacement of the southern bus entrance and construction of pavement replacement to include installation of angle curb
- Installation of perimeter wall matching existing
- Provide all necessary prep work for camera installation by Sun Metro and for real time display
- Installation of benches



Additional Information

- The demolition of the existing building located at 110 N. Harris St. is under a separate contract (Contract No. 2018-1431) it was an informal contract executed by PO.
 - Historical Commission already approved the demolition.
- The improvements as the new concrete, curb, driveway, etc are already approved by Historical Commission.
- The Installation of the three (3) canopies are pending until Historical Commission approve the final design.
