- Per Capita allocation in Texas is \$1,578


Census data is used in many ways.



In partnership with the US Census Bureau, our community has access to a variety of tools that aid in reaching the hard to reach to make sure everyone has the opportunity to be counted.




Race (Non-Hispanic) in Tract 19, El Paso County: 2012-2016


FOR EXAMPLE

- The data may help the team understand how to better reach that population.




assembling the team...

 Specialist for El Paso and the surrounding communities






O4 RESOLUTION
