- El Paso Mobility Coalition (EMCo) is a community led initiative to advocate for highway, transit, and freight rail funding for the El Paso Metropolitan Area
- Members include:

 - City of El Paso
 - Transportation construction and supply industry
 - Consulting engineers
 - Other interested organizations

Goals and Purpose:

- To identify and advocate for funding of multi-modal transportation solutions for the El Paso Metropolitan Area
- Support development and implementation of adequate transportation infrastructure solutions that will support and promote growth
- Identify and coordinate transportation infrastructure improvements in partnership with appropriate government and business entities

Goals and Purpose:

- Utilize available resources towards leveraging funds
- To publicize adequate and sustained funds are essential for improved mobility
- Develop broad base support for transportation system improvements
- Ensure that El Paso receives its share of transportation infrastructure dollars

Governance:

Committee to meet quarterly

Executive committee to meet on an ad hoc committee
City member to serve on the executive committee
