AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 20 (ZONING) TO AMEND VARIOUS SECTIONS THEREUNDER PERTAINING TO THE DUTIES AND STRUCTURE OF THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT, AND THE DUTIES OF STAFF; AND TO CLARIFY THE TYPE OF CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION; THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 20.24.020 OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, the structure of the bureaus of the Planning Department and the Building Permits and Inspections Department has been changed to make these units divisions of the Development Services Department; and

WHEREAS, various provisions in the City Code relating to the Planning Department, the Building Permits and Inspections Department, the building official and the department directors need to be amended to reflect the change in structure and titles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

Section 1. That Title 20 (Zoning), Chapter 20.02 (General Provisions and Definitions), Section 20.02.158 (Building Official) of the El Paso City Code, is amended to reconcile the definition of Building Official with that definition in Title 18, to read as follows:

20.02.158 Building official.

"Building official" means the person identified and designated in Section 18.02.101.4 of this Code.

Section 2. That Title 20 (Zoning), Chapter 20.04 (Administrative Provisions), sections 20.04.610 (Building permit application); 20.04.700 (Generally); 20.04.820 (Home occupation license), of the El Paso City Code, are amended to change the phrases "offices of the building official" and "office of the building official" to "development services department", as used within these sections, and the Code Publisher is directed to revise the applicable code provisions.

Section 3. That Title 20 (Zoning), Chapter 20.10 (Supplemental use regulations), Sections 20.10.365 (Mobile service units); 20.10.455, subsections D 3 e iii, E 3 e iii, and G 3 e iii (Personal wireless service facilities); 20.10.600 (Secondary manufactured homes

(ranch-farm district only)); and 20.10.680, subsection E, (Temporary uses), of the El Paso City Code, are amended to change the phrase "building permits and inspections division" to "development services department", as used within these sections, and the Code Publisher is directed to revise the applicable code provisions.

Section 4. That Title 20 (Zoning), Chapter 20.24 (Enforcement - Penalty), Section 20.24.020 (Criminal prosecution) of the El Paso City Code, is amended to reconcile the penalty provision with other language used in the City Code, to read as follows:

20.24.020 Criminal prosecution.

A DODTED THE

Any person violating any provision of this title shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, be fined a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars. Each day that a provision of this title is violated shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 5. Except as herein amended, Title 20 of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.
