Public Health Department recommends authorizing the Option to Extend 2013-116 Janitorial Services for WIC Clinics for 2 years for janitorial services for WIC Clinics. Exercising this option would meet the following threshold considerations:

- 1. Are funds available for this Option to Extend?
  Yes, this is a recurrent item in the department budget.
