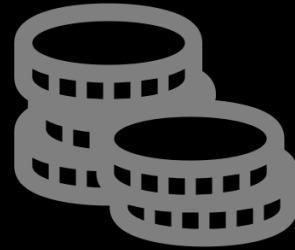

- Establish new housing programs




Dedicate Resources

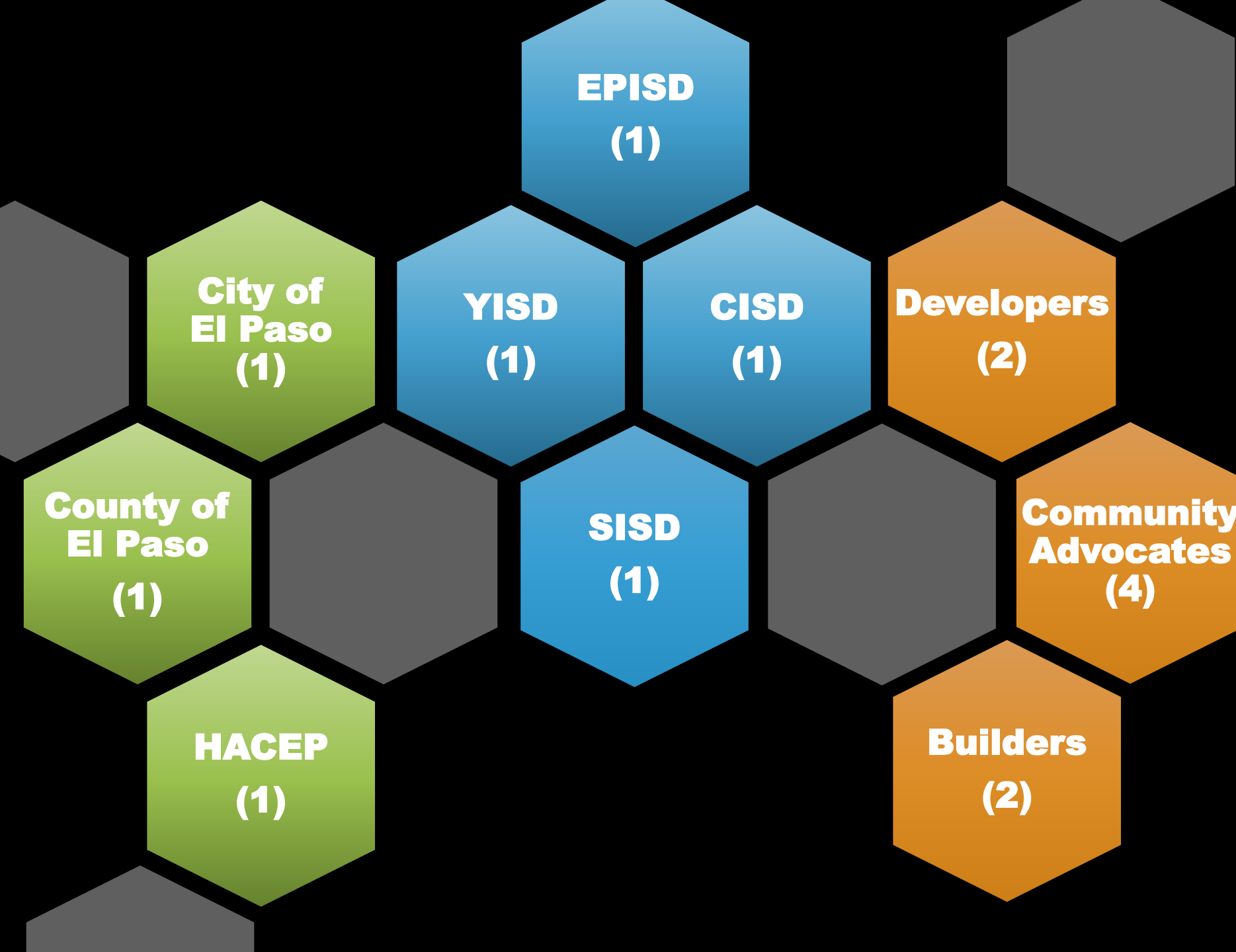
