Command Sergeant Major Reginald Daniel Sr. entered the Army in June 1979 and received his Basic Training and his Advanced Individual Training (AIT) at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, as a Cannon Crewmember (13B). During his 32 years of service, CSM Daniel has served in a variety of positions of increased responsibility to include Cannon Crew Member; Section Chief/Squad Leader; Platoon Sergeant; Drill Sergeant; First Sergeant; Battalion Operations Sergeant, Faculty Advisor and Command Sergeant Major, 1st Battalion, 10th Field Artillery, Fort Benning, Georgia and School for Command Preparation Sergeant Major and Manager of the Command Sergeant Major Course for United States Army Sergeants Major Academy and Command General Staff College located in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.

He is currently Retired after 32 years of Honorable Service in the United States Army.

CSM Daniel's assignments include tours of duty with the 2nd Battalion, 3rd Field Artillery, Butzbach, Germany; 3rd Battalion, 319th Airborne FAR (82nd Airborne Division) Fort Bragg, North Carolina; 2nd Battalion, 4th Field Artillery, Fort Lewis, Washington; 1st Battalion, 39th Field Artillery (MLRS) Fort Stewart, Georgia; HHB, 3rd Infantry Division Artillery at Fort Stewart Georgia, Morehead State University (ROTC) Cadet Command, Command Sergeant Major of the 1st Battalion, 10th Field Artillery, 3ID, 3rd Bde, Fort Benning, Georgia, United States Army Sergeants Major Academy (USASMA), Fort Bliss, Texas and Command General Staff College (CGSC), Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.
