

# Overview

**Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP)** is for **Recognized Neighborhood Associations (RNA)** to request small-scale improvement projects on City-owned property or public-right-of-way to provide additional amenities and/or aesthetic appeal.


**NIP** is funded at **\$10 million** under the **2012 Quality of Life Bond**. Funding is allocated equally per District and is competitive among RNA within the same District.

## **Strategic Goals:**

- 4.1** – Deliver bond projects impacting quality of life across the city in a timely, efficient manner
- 8.2** – Stabilize neighborhoods through community, housing and ADA improvements



# NIP Round 4 – Review Process



**Round 4 = \$3 million**

Received 56 applications

Scored 39 applications

Project requests totaled over \$9.1 million

**Recommending 19 Projects**

**Totaling = \$3,134,356**

(includes previous rounds rollover)



- ★ **Round 4**

**Round 1:** \$1 million – 15 awarded projects  
**Round 2:** \$1 million – 18 awarded projects  
**Round 3:** \$1 million – 20 awarded projects

**Round 4:** \$3 million – 19 recommend projects ★

**Round 5:** \$4 million – *Open applications in 2020*

*Total = \$10 Million 2012 Quality of Life Bond*
