AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 18 (BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION), CHAPTER 18.18 (OUTDOOR LIGHTING CODE), ARTICLE X (OTHER EXEMPTIONS), SECTION 18.18.376 (CITY-OWNED FACILITIES), TO REVISE AND ADD AN EXEMPTION RELATED TO THE EL PASO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TERMINAL AND AIRFIELD; THE PENALTY IS AS PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 18.18.400 OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, Title 18 (Building and Construction) of the El Paso City Code was adopted to promote the health safety, and general welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the unique characteristics of the Airport, serving as a destination point for residents and visitors, and also as an environment subject to particular operational and development requirements; and

WHEREAS, exemptions from the outdoor lighting code for airport terminal decorative and landscaping elements are reasonable and necessary in order to promote the City's long-term vision to have safe and beautiful neighborhoods, a vibrant regional economy and exceptional recreational and cultural opportunities; and

WHEREAS, exemptions from the outdoor lighting code for airfield infrastructure are reasonable and necessary in order to support air operations and grow the core business of air transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

**SECTION 1.** That Title 18 (Building and Construction), Chapter 18.18 (Outdoor Lighting Code), Section 18.18.376 (City-owned Facilities) of the El Paso City Code be amended as follows:

## 18.18.376 - City-owned facilities.

The following City owned properties and projects are exempt from complying with the intent of this Code:

- 1. Spray parks;
- 2. The El Paso International Airport, which for the purposes of this section is from a point beginning at the intersection of Montana Ave. and the Texas and New Orleans Railroad ROW north and west along the southwest boundary line of El Paso International

Airport Tracts Replat A to Airport Rd., north to Airway Blvd., east to Convair Rd., north and east along Convair Rd. across Terminal Dr. to Northrop Dr., south and west to American Dr., south to Boeing Dr., east to Sikorsky St., south to Montana Ave., and west to the point of beginning, to include the airport terminal building and all property located within the Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) and the airport security perimeter.

SECTION 2. Except as expressly herein amended, Title 18 (Building and Construction), Chapter 18.18 (Outdoor Lighting Code) of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.
