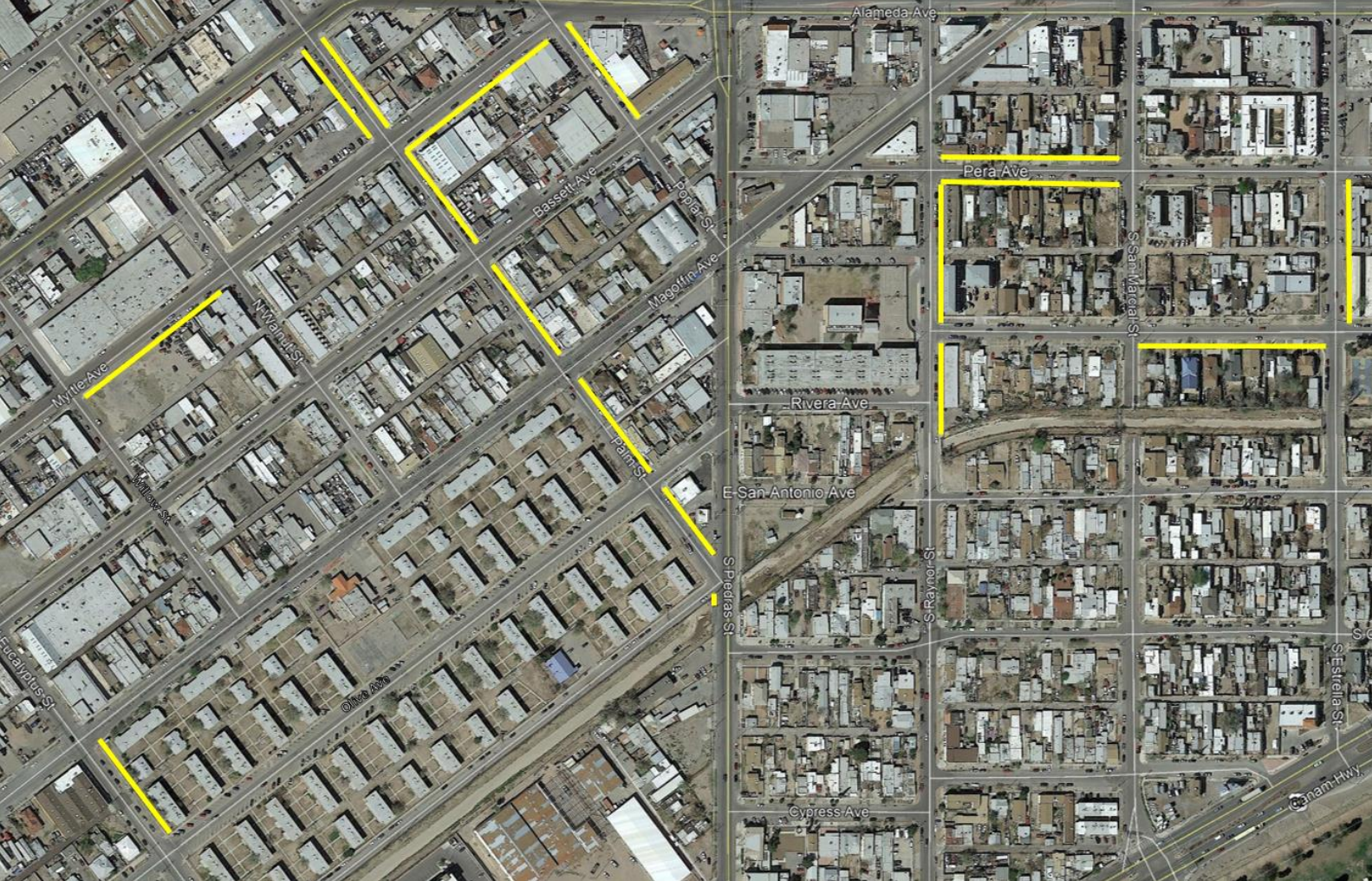
Project Scope

- The goal is to facilitate pedestrian access to public transportation systems.
- Project scope includes **pedestrian enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements in the Chamizal Neighborhood**: N. Eucalyptus from Magoffin Ave to Olive Ave, Palm St from Texas Ave to S. Piedras St, Myrtle Ave from Willow St to Walnut St and Palm St to Poplar St, Poplar St from Myrtle Ave to Bassett Ave, Pera St from S. Raynor to S. San Marcial St, S. Raynor St from Pera Ave to Rivera St, Rivera Ave from S. San Marcial St to S. Estrella, and S. Estrella St from Pera Ave to Rivera Ave.
