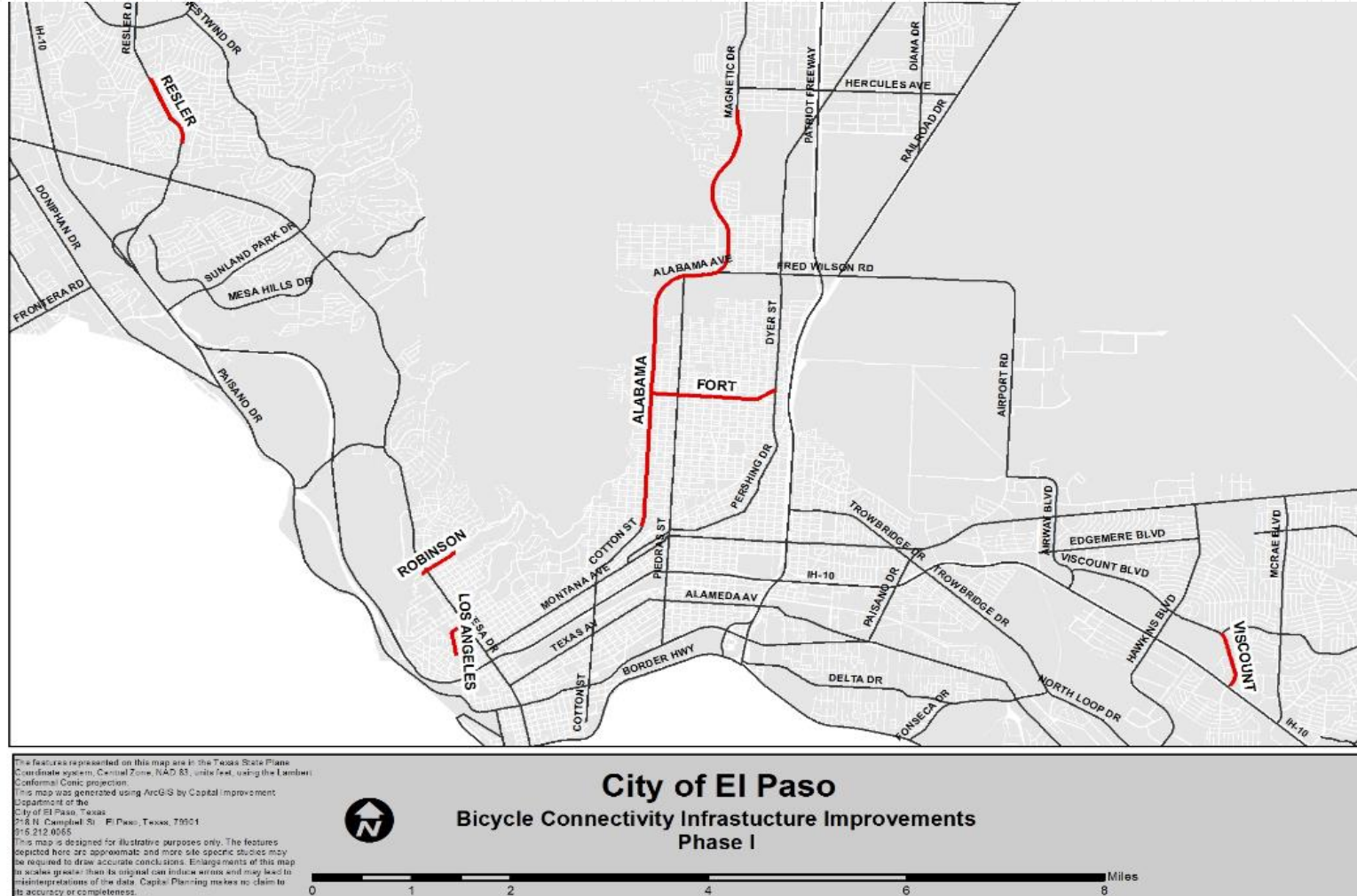
Project Scope

- The goal is to promote the use of bicycles as a means of transportation.
- Project scope includes **the construction of bicycle facilities citywide** to include: buffered bike lanes, conventional bike lanes, bicycle boulevards, and shared lane markings. The project will include associated signage, wayfinding, striping, and intersection treatments. Limits: Alabama from Atlas to Arizona, Viscount from Montwood to I-10, Resler from Belvidere to Enid, Robinson from Oregon to Virginia, Fort from Alabama to Dyer, and Los Angeles from Yandell to Oregon.
