1. Call to Order

Chair Robert Gonzales called the meeting to order at 11:07 a.m.

Mr. Gutierrez made a motion recommending the continuation of the green paint to connect with the paint proposed at the intersection of Stanton and Baltimore, that the bike lane be widened where it approaches Baltimore heading southbound to give the buffer space to the bike lane. Seconded by Mr. Eyberg.
