- 1. Call to Order: Meeting Called to Order at 10:06 AM.
- 2. Roll Call: Quorum.
- 3. Discussion and Action: Annual election of VAAC Officers. Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary.

- 4. Citizen Comment Period: (individuals limited to 3 minutes; no specific action may be taken). Alma Aranda briefed about the Microsoft learning pathways and would like to have a presentation to the VAAC. Alma will attempt to brief during the February meeting.
- 5. Community Update: Presentation of the "Visit El Paso" App Destination El Paso. Nora Rose of the El Paso Chamber of Commerce presented the Visit El Paso App. This App is to promote the quality of life for the community of El Paso. The military tab is focused on Soldiers and their families at Ft. Bliss. It is also designed to help Veterans find resources in employment and education.

- 6. Receive an Update on the Veterans Permanent Supportive Housing Program Ben Miranda of Endeavors. Endeavors is pending to receive the contract by the end of the month of January. Endeavors has already picked two case managers with great experience and roots in El Paso to facilitate the program. Endeavors has pre-identified Veterans to receive assistance through the program.
- 7. Receive an Update from City HR on Veteran Employment Cecy Mungaray. Job posting language "must have" for minimum requirements has been removed. Postings now just have the minimum qualifications. New tracking system shows total number of Veterans Eligible and total number of Veterans Hired. Veterans are highlighted on the job eligible lists for hiring managers to easily identify who are Veterans. Hiring managers receive the entire eligible list and decide how many people they would like to interview. The list of how many Veterans were eligible, interviewed and hired will be sent to the Chief Military Officer monthly. Cecy mentioned to have any Veteran interested in obtaining employment at the City to please send her their resume and allow her to help them with the application process.

- 9. Discussion and Action: Schedule Special Meeting for the preparation for the Semi-Annual Brief to Council. Sub-committees will meet virtually on January 22nd 10 AM.
