## (a) Budget Update

Paola Gallegos presents on the budget stating that in fiscal year 2019 the board has \$37,916.61 in recognized revenue and \$3,782.61 in expenses. In total, the committee has a balance of \$41,698.84.

John Moye asks about schedules, there are still two police officers per weekend at five hours every night.

#### (b) Police Update

Lieutenant Lujan presents findings; from January 25 to present, they have had sixteen working days for eight weekends. In conclusion, the Lieutenant felt the additional police officers were well received by the businesses and community. Significant incidents police have encountered include fights, two vehicle accidents, criminal trespass and multiple incident reports.

# (b) District Cleanup

Paola Gallegos explains that district clean up would cost \$4,162 per cleaning. This would include trash and debris clean up from Campbell to Stanton and Mississippi to New York.

John Moye asks about power wash cleaning and the expenses in the district.

Paola Gallegos clarifies that it is \$200 to clean Cincinnati, and an estimated \$2,400 for power washing in that same area.

Michael Myers states that the area seems cleaner and the board should consider a quarterly pressure wash instead of cleaning weekly.

Paola Gallegos presents memo to the board. Capital Improvements will look into the bollards, and ask the board to identify where they would like additional trees throughout the district.

Gloria Viramontes presents her design to install planters and benches to beautify her storefront.

The committee directs staff to look into beautifying the alley by installing overhead string lights.

Staff will look into consolidating dumpsters in the district, alleyway improvements and lighting.
