III. General Manager's Update: Bryan Crowe

- Introduction of Amanda Fernandez as the Executive Assistant/Office Manager. Lauren has been moved to the receptionist position.
- Destination El Paso has been very involved with Borderplex Alliance's Tourism Task Force and with the Chihuahua CVB.
 - The Chihuahua CVB hosted Ryan, Brooke, Veronica and I last week in Juarez during the Mexico Association of Marketing Destinations conference.

IV. Department Updates

- Financials: Bryan Crowe
- Financial Narrative
 - The numbers below represent the beginning of the 2015 fiscal year.
 - Total revenue for the month of April 2016 was \$510,743 bringing Total YTD revenue budget to \$3,292,257
 - Total expenses for El Paso Live for the month of April 2016 were \$678,085 bringing YTD expenses to \$4,283,594
 - Total expenses for Visit El Paso for the month of April 2016 were \$242,567 bringing YTD expenses to \$1,849,162
 - YTD we are experiencing a negative variance of \$89,660
 - YTD after the influx of City of El Paso funding there is an Adjusted Net Loss of \$185,746
 - Dick Behrenhausen commented that Oishii is still staggering. Bryan informed the members that start up restaurants take some time to show profits and he will work with management to hopefully make it profitable.
 - Georgina Panahi asked for historical information regarding attendance from last year compared to this year for Alfresco Fridays and Cool Canyon Nights. The information will be sent out to the board.
 - El Paso Live will have four Music Under The Stars performances at Cohen Stadium for the month of June.

• Tourism Development: Veronica Castro

- New Mexico Governor's Conference
 - Bryan and I participated in the conference held in Las Cruces May 16 and 17.
 They had over 300 participants from the state of NM.

Neon Desert Music Fest

- o All four hotels in the downtown area were sold out or close to sold out.
- Visit El Paso hosted two publications from Mexico; Nylon Entertainment Magazine and GQ Mexico. They were here for four days covering Neon Desert Music Fest and they also took in some of El Paso's attractions. They visited the Wyler Aerial Tramway, saw a Chihuahuas game, and went in a hot air balloon which was part of KLAQ's Balloon Fest.
- GQ Mexico produced a story on line which was shared on Visit El Paso's social media.
- Nylon will produce 5 stories, 2 of which already posted. They discussed helping us market Neon Desert Music Fest in Mexico City for next year.

- June 1-4, 2016 in Mexico; Visit El Paso sponsored their coffee breaks and participated in the conference.
- Last Tuesday we did several interviews with media from Mexico to talk about the partnership we are doing with the City of El Paso.
- Visit El Paso hosted a post tour for those individuals that wanted to extend their stay. 17 meeting planners, tour operators and international media participated in the post tour.

 downtown walking tour to include the stadium, and shopping at the Outlets,

 had dinner at Oishii.
