### III. General Manager's Update: Bryan Crowe

- Maria Schneider has resigned as Director of Marketing. We have hired Holly Fields as Marketing Manager and Lauren Falco as Marketing Coordinator.
- City Council approved to begin the incentive process for the Camino Real Hotel redevelopment project.
  - Set to close on the property in September.
  - The hotel will operate as a full hotel while under renovation and renovations will be complete in late 2018 or early 2019.
  - The convention development team has started the process to reach out to meeting planners.
- Effective end of June we closed Oishii.
- Reviewed historical information regarding attendance from last year compared to this year for Alfresco Fridays and Cool Canyon Nights.

- Financial Narrative
  - Total revenue for the month of May 2016 was \$732,203 bringing Total YTD revenue budget to \$4,024,463
  - Total expenses for El Paso Live for the month of May 2016 were \$599,870
     bringing YTD expenses to \$4,883,475
  - Total expenses for Visit El Paso for the month of May 2016 were \$315,903 bringing YTD expenses to \$2,165,044
  - YTD we are experiencing a negative variance of \$30,372
  - YTD after the influx of City of El Paso funding there is an Adjusted Net Loss of \$37,458

# • Tourism Development: Veronica Castro presented by Brooke Underwood

- The department hosted a Post-Tour for 12 tour operators, meeting planners and travel
  writers from all over Mexico who were in Cd. Juarez attending Association of Marketing
  Destination in Mexico. These individuals spent Saturday and Sunday getting to know our
  attractions, cuisine and shopping.
- The Tourism department hosted 4 Tour Operators from Chihuahua, 2 Travel Writers from Torreon and 2 Travel Writers from El Heraldo de Chihuahuas in conjunction with the

Mayor's FAM. The El Heraldo de Chihuahua has already produced two editorials regarding their visit to El Paso.

- We are hosting two bloggers from San Diego July 22-25. They will be here for three days exploring El Paso. We've invited them in hopes of them promoting our new nonstop service from San Diego to El Paso on Allegiant Air, its affordable and we are certainly an affordable destination for those people trying to experience something unique and authentic. Their blog is Travel the World and it has 24,818 unique visits, 3,032 Facebook "Likes", 16,463 Twitter followers.
- In May of this year we hosted Malcolm MacMillian from MLB Blog Network, he was doing a series on minor league baseball teams in Texas. Malcolm fell in love with El Paso and the Chihuahuas, he has already written two blogs about his experience in El Paso. Just recently he wrote us an email thanking us for sharing his first blog about El Paso the day after he published it. He had the highest traffic of any single day since starting his blog. He also received a lot of comments, tweets, etc. from El Paso residents who were happy with the coverage. He also was featured in the El Paso Times while he was here.

## • Convention Development: Brooke Underwood

- FAM Update
  - Visit El Paso received an RFP upon return, Texas Association of Public Employee Retirement Systems, Summer Education Forum for August 2019. The organization represents 450 in attendance, is projected to utilize 350 rooms on peak night and fill 990 total room nights during their stay.
- Visit El Paso partnered with the local Chapter of Special Forces Association to secure the National Convention for June 2018. The organization represents 1,200 in attendance, is projected to utilize 300 rooms on peak night and fill 1,225 total room nights during their stay.
- Cathy Stevens will travel to Montgomery, AL July 28-31, 2016 to make a bid presentation to the National Horseshoe Pitcher's Association's general delegation to host the World Championship Tournament in July 2018. The competition is Florence, SC and Shreveport, LA with a decision expected to follow the bid presentations. Cathy will exhibit; pass out information on El Paso and network for votes. The association represents 1,400 in attendance, is projected to utilize 225 rooms on peak night and fill 3,190 total room nights during their stay.
