III. General Manager's Update: Bryan Crowe

- Reviewed the orientation manual with all board members.
- Bryan discussed the IBTM convention in Mexico City that was attended by Bryan, Brooke Underwood and Veronica Castro along with the Juarez BCV.

- Bryan talked about his recent presentation to the Destination Marketing Association International Visitor Services Summit regarding the El Paso app and our Virtual Visitor Center that uses FaceTime.

 - Financial Narrative for June and July
 - Total revenue for the month of June 2016 was \$450,307 bringing Total YTD revenue budget to \$4,474,762
 - Total expenses for El Paso Live for the month of June 2016 were \$747,708 bringing YTD expenses to \$5,631,102
 - Total expenses for Visit El Paso for the month of June 2016 were \$328,275 bringing YTD expenses to \$2,493,318
 - YTD we are experiencing a negative variance of \$272,432
 - YTD after the influx of City of El Paso funding there is an Adjusted Net Loss of \$331,216
 - Total revenue for the month of July 2016 was \$518,870 bringing Total YTD revenue budget to \$4,993,636
 - Total expenses for El Paso Live for the month of July 2016 were \$470,543 bringing YTD expenses to \$6,118,496
 - Total expenses for Visit El Paso for the month of July 2016 were \$249,946 bringing YTD expenses to \$2,743,261

- We are currently hosting a travel writer Elaine Masters also from San Diego who writes for Trip Wellness and has a podcast on traveling. She is spending a few days in El Paso and in Marfa.
- Veronica showed the board the new visitor guide which is distributed to all hotels and any other outlets that requests the visitor guide.
- Veronica is working on creating packages for travel writers to include hotel, excursions and attend events such as Neon Desert.

- Cathy Stevens and Sarah Salazar attended Connect Market Place in Grapevine and came back with 12 RFPs.
- We hosted TACVB convention in August which was last here 3 years ago. We showcased all the new and exciting things that have happened in El Paso in the past 3 years.

- Cathy will also attend the TEAMS Sports Conference September 26-30 and she will be meeting with pre-qualified Event Rights Holders to try and attract more sports business to the city.
