MINUTES

1. Call to Order. Meeting called to order at 3.49 pm.

2. Roll Call.

Members Present: Jesus E. Carrillo, Cathy Chen, Laura Jaquez, Edgar Lopez, and Adam Marshall.

Members Absent: Sarelah Aguilar and Josue Muñoz.

Others Present: Miriam Garcia, Adrian Guzman, and Luz Ibarra.

3. Public Comment. None.

4. Approval of Minutes. Adam Marshall requested a motion to approve the October 08, 2019 minutes. Edgar Lopez seconded. All members voted in favor, none opposed, motion passed unanimously.

5. Discussion and action on the 2020 Public Art Plan. Miriam Garcia presented the 2020 Public Art Annual Plan. The program has completed 60 projects, established the Art Purchase Program with 112 acquisitions, established the Allied Artist Program, and it has impacted 91 local businesses with Public Art Projects. The Public Art Program has received 10 National awards and has been featured in 9 National publications. Per ordinance, the program presents the Public Art Annual Plan annually to the Public Art Committee (PAC), Museums and Cultural Affairs Advisory Board (MCAAB) and City Council for approval. Ms. Garcia stated that the Public Art Plan presented every year aligns with the 2014-2024 Public Art Master Plan Alignment. She mentioned that the new projects focus on three specific recommendations: 1. Creating identity for visitors and residents. 2. Reinforcing places of gathering and meaning in neighborhoods. 3. Lastly, strengthening downtown and other areas of urban investment as pedestrian-oriented cultural and economic resources. Ms. Garcia listed the projects completed in 2019 and the projects near completion. The following projects were completed in 2019; *Conexion*, *Alameda Brio*, *Camouflage*, and *Persistencia*. The projects near completion are as follows, *Flores del Desierto*, *Jackrabbit Jumps the Bartlett Ball*, *Eastside Regional Park Plaza*, *Carolina Bridge*, and *RC Poe Roundabout*. Adam Marshall interjected and asked about the lighting of *Flores del Desierto*, if one of the pieces would go out would it affect the whole art piece? Ms. Garcia responded that every piece or "flower" has their own lighting panel and it wouldn't affect the whole piece. Moving forward, Ms. Garcia proceeded and described the new projects and new allocations to the 2020 Public Art Plan. (Attached as part of these minutes) She listed 10 new projects that have been added to the 2020 Public Art Plan and will be evenly distributed among the districts in the City of El Paso. Ms. Garcia concluded with listing the 27 projects that are in progress. (Attached as part of these minutes). Laura Jaquez made a motion to approve the 2020 Public Art Plan. Adam Marshall Seconded. All members voted in favor, none opposed, motion passed unanimously.

6. Adjournment. Laura Jaquez motioned to adjourn the meeting, Adam Marshall seconded. All members voted in favor, none opposed, motion passed unanimously. Meeting was adjourned at 4:39pm. Next meeting scheduled for December 10, 2019.
