MINUTES

1. Call to Order. Meeting called to order at 3:33 p.m.

2. Roll Call.

Members Present: Ivan Nino, Sarelah Aguilar, Claudia Ley, Laura Jaquez, Edgar Lopez, Lucio Glenn, Floyd Johnson, Alejandro Mireles,

Members Absent: Jesus Carrillo, and Daniel Szwaczkowski

Others Present: Miriam Garcia, Adrian Guzman, Josephine Jimarez-Howard, and Rocio Rivas

3. Public Comment. None.

4. Approval of Minutes. Floyd Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes from November 9th, 2021. Edgar Lopez seconded the motion. All members voted in favor, none opposed, motion passed unanimously.

5. Discussion and action on Election of Vice-Chair. It was presented to the Public Art Committee that the position of Vice Chair was open for nominations. Lucio Glenn nominated Claudia Ley. Ms. Ley accepted the nomination. Lucio Glen made a motion to appoint Ms. Ley as the Vice Chair. Laura Jaquez seconded the motion. All members voted in favor of Ms. Ley as Vice-Chair, none opposed, motion passed unanimously.

6. Discussion and Action on 2022 Public Art Plan. Miriam. Garcia, Public Art Program Supervisor presented the 2022 Public Art Plan to the PAC. Members asked a few questions concerning the new projects and how artists would be selected for them. Edgar Lopez asked about the location of the projects and what sort of art projects would best be utilized. Ms. Garcia stated that the Paso Del Norte Roundabout project would be located at the downtown international bridge and serve as a welcoming gesture to visitors from Mexico. At the Eastside Sports Complex, public art would serve as way-finding for guests to the complex. Sarelah Aguilar motioned to approve the plan, Edgar Lopez seconded the motion, all members voted in favor, none opposed, motion passed unanimously.

7. Discussion and Action on final artist selection for Alabama Mural Replacement. Ivan Nino presented the artist selection for the Alabama Mural Replacement Project made by the Artist Selection Panel (ASP) on 11-18-2021 in which he represented the Public Art Committee. He detailed that the ASP chose to elect Jesus "Cimi" Alvarado as the chosen artist to design and paint the new mural. Edgar Lopez requested to see all the artist presentations. After the PAC viewed all the presentations for the mural replacement project, Floyd Johnson made a motion to approve Jesus "Cimi" Alvarado as the final artist selection for the Alabama Mural Replacement Project. Claudia Ley seconded the motion. All members voted in favor, none opposed, motion passed unanimously.

8. Adjournment. Ivan Nino motioned to adjourn the meeting. Laura Jaquez seconded the motion. All members voted in favor, none opposed, motioned passed. Meeting adjourned at 4:05 PM MST.
