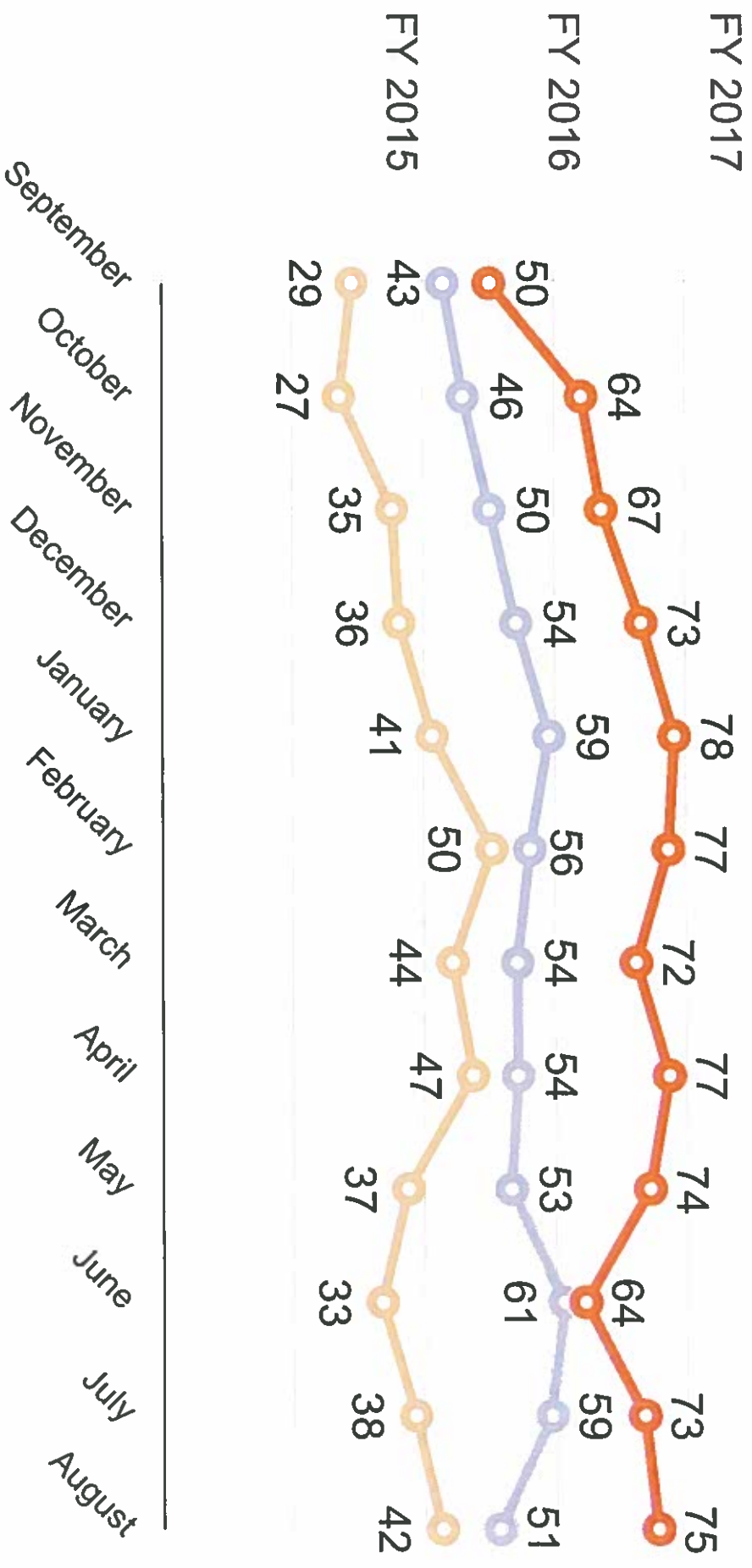


LIVE-RELEASE RATES CALENDAR YEAR

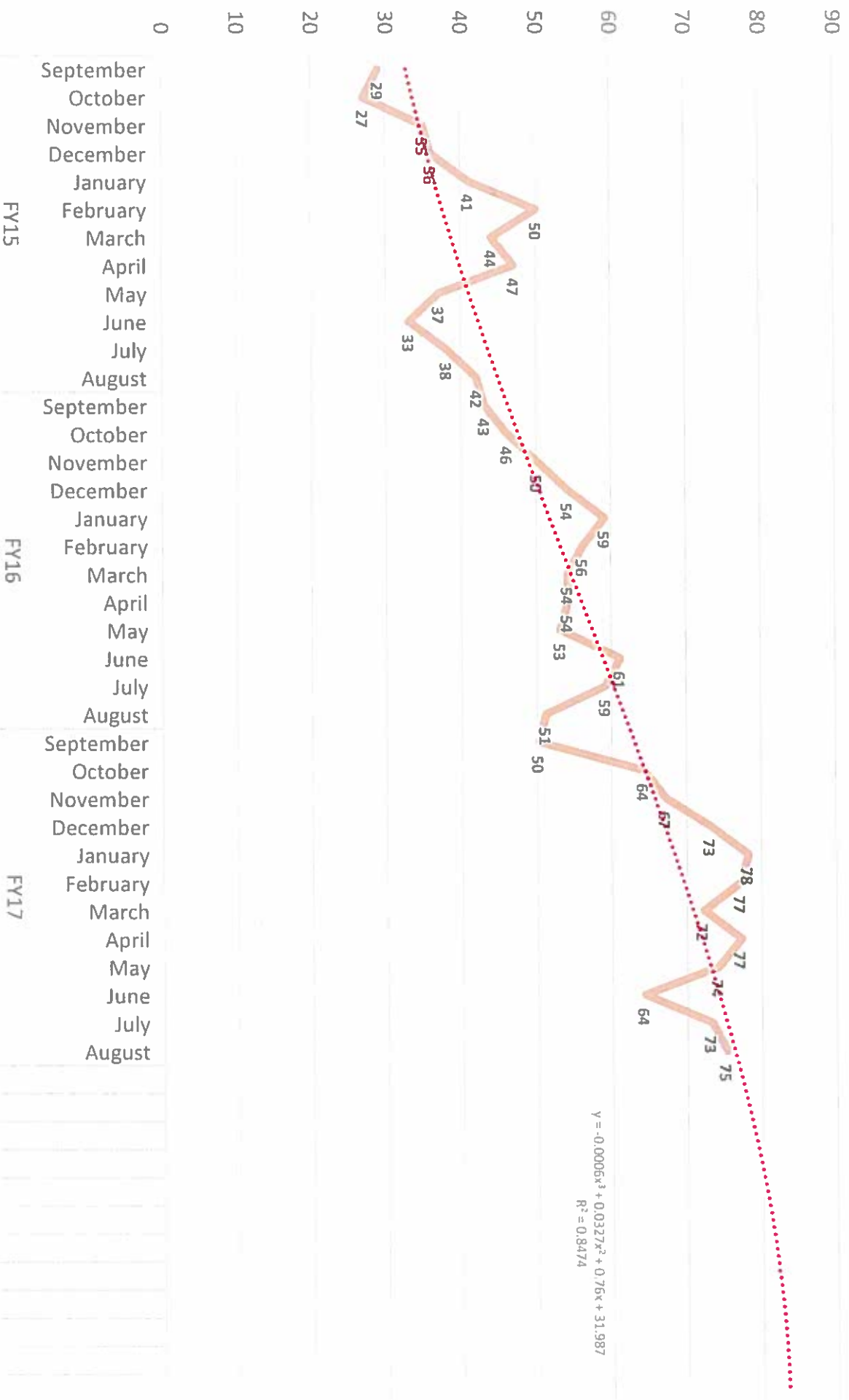

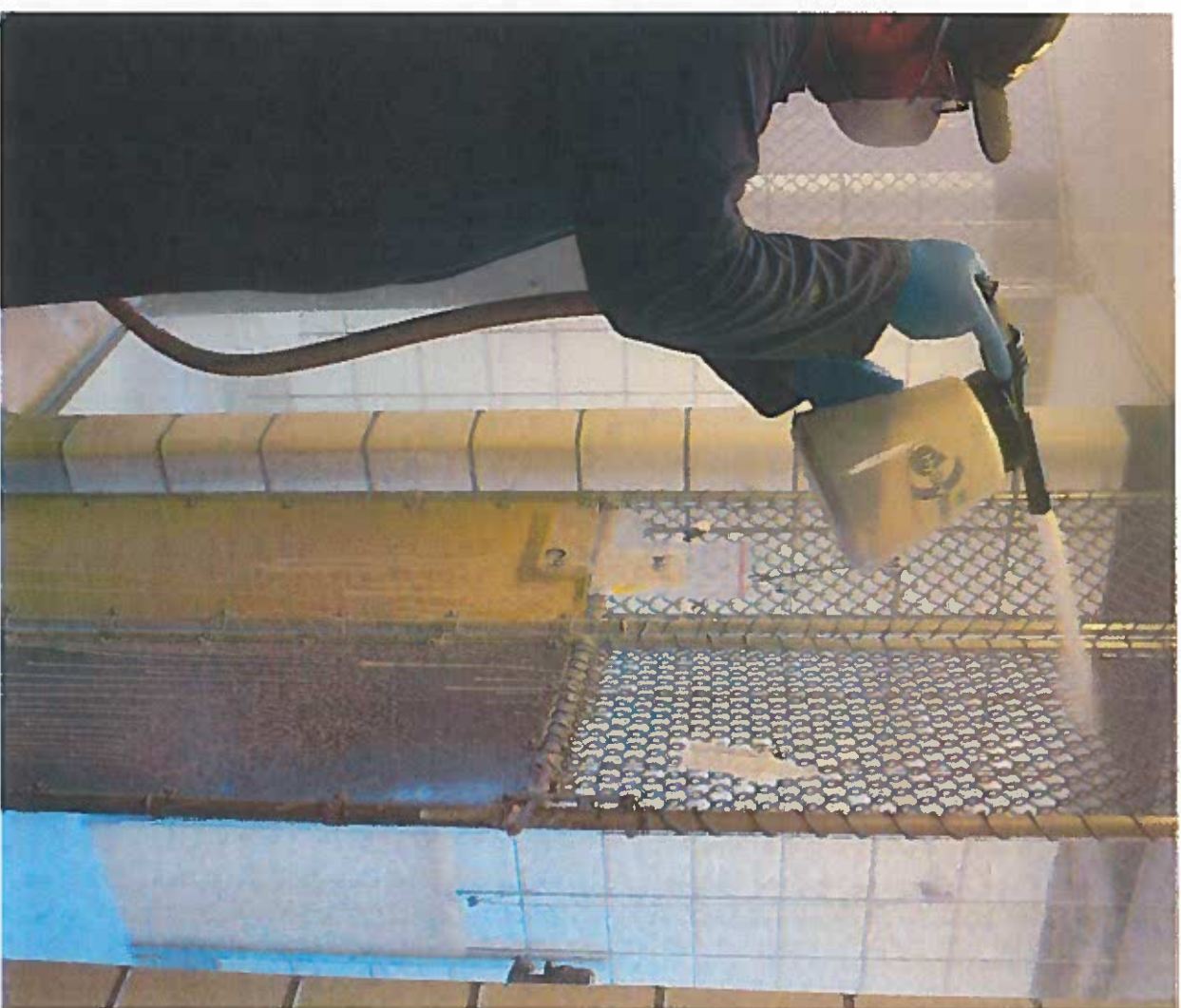
