1. Meeting Called to Order

Chairwoman Balin called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m.

2. Call to the Public (items not listed on the Agenda)

Larry Nichols, began the Call to the Public discussion explaining a request from District 2, City Council Representative Tolbert for Planning staff to investigate who exactly owns the property and easements with regard to the fence along the trail leading up to the 1,000 steps mountain trail. There may be a possibility the property adjacent to the fence is owned by KFOX or some other communications companies having easement agreements. Staff will research and present their findings to the OSAB and Representative Tolbert.

Chairwoman Balin, Vice-Chairman Dr. Bonart and Board Members Baumgardt, White and Dr. Teschner responded to comments from staff.

Scott Cutler, Franklin Mountain Wilderness Coalition, stated The Franklin Mountain Wilder Coalition, in working with other wilderness groups, have been interested in acquiring Parcels 2, 3, 4 and Parcel 1. In the long run, the public would be better served if these parcels were targeted for purchase with whatever means the city and OSAB could arrange.

Ms. Nieman explained public comment is the opportunity for members of the public to present items/issues, not posted on the agenda, to the attention of the Board. - 1. THAT WE REQUEST THAT STAFF BEGIN TO NOTIFY THE ENTIRE BOARD OF UPCOMING CPC MEETINGS THAT ARE INVOLVING HDA AND MDA SO INDIVIDUALS CAN PARTICIPANT AND SO A BETTER SOLUTION IS RESOLVED;
- 2. THAT WE WRITE A RESOLUTION AND THAT RESOLUTION SHOULD BE WORDED SUCH THAT WE REQUEST THAT CITY COUNCIL DIRECT STAFF TO HELP OSAB CONSTRUCT AN AMENDMENT TO THE TITLE 19 WITH THE INTENDED PURPOSE TO PROVIDE PUBLIC ACCESS TO ALL OPEN SPACE ASSETS; AND
- 3. THAT WE CONTINUE ON THE PATH OF LOOKING AT AND MEETING WITH STAFF TO SEE IF THERE IS ANY WAY WE MIGHT STILL BE INVOLVED ON A PROACTIVE BASIS RATHER THAN A REACTIVE BASIS WITH SOME OF THESE LAND STUDIES AND SUBDIVISIONS THAT COME BEFORE THE CPC.

Dr. Teschner then read into the record his proposed amendments to Section 19.24.020 – Procedure and requirements as follows:

Change the third sentence of this section to read as follows (the added words are underlines):

However, prior to city plan commission action, all subdivision applications within the Mountain Development Area shall be presented to the open space advisory board (OSAB) for advice and comments in its regularly scheduled meetings or if necessary in extraordinary meetings called in advance of a city plan commission meeting provided, however, that failure of OSAB to provide comments to the city plan commission prior to the city plan commission meeting in which the plat will be considered, shall not prevent the city plan commission from taking action on the plat and shall not be a basis for denial of the plat if the plat conforms to other provisions of Title 19.

Motion made by Dr. Teschner, seconded by Vice-Chairman Dr. Bonart AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED TO BRING THE ABOVE PROPOSED CODE AMENDMENT LANGUAGE TO CITY COUNCIL.

- 1. THAT WE ASK STAFF TO NOTIFY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF UPCOMING MEETINGS AT THE CPC WHICH INVOLVE EITHER MDA OR HDA SUBDIVISION OR LAND STUDIES SO THAT IF INDIVIDUALS WISH TO ATTEND THEY WILL KNOW THAT THOSE ARE ON THE AGENDA; AND
- 2. THAT WE DRAFT A RESOLUTION FOR CITY COUNCIL TO ASK THEM TO DIRECT CITY STAFF TO HELP DRAFT AN AMENDMENT TO TITLE 19 TO MAKE SURE SUBDIVISIONS ARE CONSTRUCTED IN A MANNER SO THAT THERE IS ACCESS TO OPEN SPACE ASSETS.
