OPINION

Appellant was cited for failure to maintain financial responsibility on December 28, 2020. A fine of \$211.00 was assessed as well a court costs of \$36.00 and an arrest fee of \$5.00 which are provided by law in the event of a conviction.


Appellant did not obtain insurance until January 5, 2021 as is evidenced by the letter and Allstate Insurance Card filed with this Court.

This Court has considered Mr. Ibarra's letter and the proof submitted and Mr. Ibarra's claim that he was unable to obtain insurance because the Dodge Neon had to be repaired does not constitute legal authority to reverse the Trial Court's judgment in this case.

In his letter to this Court, Mr. Ibarra admits he drove the vehicle in question and that it was not insured on the date and time of the citation.

Therefore, the judgment of the Trial Court is affirmed because Appellant, among other things, admits his guilt.
