**OPINION**

Appellant was cited on June 17, 2024 for parking her vehicle in a buffer zone.

The case was heard on June 24, 2024. Appellant was assessed a fine of \$25.00 and court costs.

On June 24, 2024, Appellant filed a statement in which she claims there was sufficient space in the parking area between her vehicle and the vehicle in front of her vehicle.

This Court has jurisdiction over appeals in municipal courts of record. The parking hearing order it is unclear whether Appellant was informed that she had a right to request a record. See Texas Government Code Section 30.00014. Appellant must be given the opportunity to request or decline a record of the trial court proceedings.

Under such circumstances, this Court reverses and remands the case to the trial court as Appellant must be advised she has a right to request a record of the proceedings. *See Sherman v. State*, Cause No. 06-MCA-3084.

The Trial Court's judgment is reversed and remanded for proceedings consistent with this opinion.


