## **OPINION**

Appellant was cited on October 21, 2022 for failing to have a current texas certificate of registration.

The case was heard before the Court on February 2, 2023. Appellant was assessed a fine of \$100.00, court costs of \$134.00 and a \$5.00 arrest fee.

Appellant's Brief argues the trial court erred in finding Appellant guilty as he was not transporting an individual for compensation, does not participate in commerce but was "just traveling" when he was pulled over by the police officer.

The court has considered Appellant's argument; however, the State is only required to prove the elements of the complaint and that is, Appellant unlawfully operated a vehicle on a public street that failed to have a current texas certificate of registration displated on said vehicle. This Court's jurisdiction is limited by law to determining whether the Trial Court committed an error of fact or law during the trial.

There is no record of the evidence introduced before the Trial Court, and the record before this Court indicates no record was requested by Appellant. Under such circumstances, this Court cannot contradict the factual or legal findings of the trial court without a record to review.
