OPINION

Appellant was cited on July 19, 2022 for a speeding violation.

The case heard before the Court on October 17, 2022. Appellant was assessed a fine of \$61.00, court costs of \$134.00 and a \$5.00 arrest fee.

Appellant filed a letter in support of his appeal in which Appellant states he claims the officer stated Appellant was traveling "50 in a 40." Appellant then refers this court to the citation that states Appellant was traveling 60 miles per hour in a 50 mile per hour zone and requests the case be dismissed as the officer contradicts himself.

The court has reviewed Appellant's letter and argument however, this Court's jurisdiction is limited by law to determining whether the Trial Court committed an error of fact or law during the trial.

There is no record of the evidence introduced before the Trial Court, and the record before this Court indicates no record was requested by Appellant. Under such circumstances, this Court cannot second guess the judgment of the Trial Court who heard the evidence or overrule the Trial Court's factual findings without a record to review.

The Trial Court's judgment is affirmed.
