On June 27, 2024, Appellant failed to provide a statement supporting his appeal.

This Court has jurisdiction over appeals in municipal courts of record. The parking hearing order it is unclear whether Appellant was informed that he had a right to request a record. See Texas Government Code Section 30.00014. Appellant must be given the opportunity to request or decline a record of the trial court proceedings.

Under such circumstances, this Court reverses and remands the case to the trial court as Appellant must be advised he has a right to request a record of the proceedings. *See Sherman v. State*, Cause No. 06-MCA-3084.

The Trial Court's judgment is revered and remanded for proceedings consistent with this opinion.
