AMENDED OPINION

Appellant was cited on April 26, 2023 for a fictitious plate and speeding.

The case heard before the Trial Court on July 3, 2023. Appellant was assessed a fine of \$111.75, court costs of \$96.00 and a \$5.00 arrest fee.

On July 28, 2023, Appellant filed a statement in which he claims he was not speeding.

The Defendant did not address the fictitious plate in his statement to the Court.

This Court has reviewed Appellant's letter and argument--however, this Court's jurisdiction is limited by law to determining whether the Trial Court committed an error of fact or law during the trial.

Although the Defendant requested a record and an audio recording of the trial was made, the Defendant failed to file a reporter's record timely even after this Court informed the Defendant that a reporter's record needed to be filed for this Court to consider his appeal. Under such circumstances, this Court cannot reverse the judgment of the Trial Court who heard the evidence or overrule the Trial Court's factual findings without a record to review.

The Trial Court's judgment is affirmed.
