OPINION

Appellant was cited on July 19, 2022 for a red light violation.

The case heard before the Trial Court on February 17, 2023. Appellant was assessed a fine of \$25.00, court costs of \$134.00 and a \$5.00 arrest fee.

On May 20, 2023, this Court mailed a notice of intent to dismiss as Appellant had failed to file his brief within the time provided by Chapter 30, Subchapter B, Section 30.067 of the Government Code.

On July 3, 2023, Appellant filed a statement in which he claims "running a yellow light is not the same as running a red light."

This Court has reviewed Appellant's letter and argument--however, this Court's jurisdiction is limited by law to determining whether the Trial Court committed an error of fact or law during the trial.

There is no record of the evidence introduced before the Trial Court, and the record before this Court indicates no record was requested by Appellant. Under such circumstances, this Court cannot reverse the judgment of the Trial Court who heard the evidence or overrule the Trial Court's factual findings without a record to review.

The Trial Court's judgment is affirmed.
